FVMA Foundation Grant Application Requirements

The FVMA Executive Board of Directors unanimously approved the creation of a grant process where veterinarian members of the FVMA can apply for up to a \$5,000 special project grant to be used for various purposes as long as the request meets the following criteria.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY:

1. That the special project have a tangible effect on the FVMA membership.
2. That the special project impact a significant number of veterinarians.
3. That the special project promote the profession and enhance the image of veterinarians.
4. The veterinarian applying for the grant must be a member in good standing of the FVMA.
5. All grant application requests must be made 60 days before the FVMA Board of Governor's Annual Summer Meeting, which will be held Aug. 1-2, 2009. The board will vote on the requests at the meeting and you will be notified of their decision. The deadline for submissions is Tuesday, June 2, 2009.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Applications will be available online at the FVMA's web site, www.fvma.com or by calling the FVMA at 800-992-3862.

Fill out the grant application form in its entirety. Incomplete forms will not be considered. The maximum grant amount is \$5,000.00. Please be sure to specify on the application form the amount requested. Also be specific in explaining the reason you are requesting the grant and how it will be used. Also include an expected completion date.
